Rules and Regulations

Participants must specify the category food item to be judged in along with their name. All entries must be delivered to the festival site by 11:30am for the 12:00pm judging by CIA judges. All entries become the property of *The Heart of the Hudson Valley Festival* and your container and its' contents WILL NOT BE RETURNED.

All participants must submit the attached entry form with each food item(s) to be judged.

- Locally grown produce **MUST** be listed as one of the ingredients. You may expect to be asked a few questions by the judges as to your preparation and/or content.

All entries will be judged as follows:

- 25% of the score goes to originality
- 50% of the score goes to taste and texture
- 25% of the score goes to appearance and presentation

The categories are as follows:

- J Jams/Jellies/Preserves
- C Homemade Dip/Salad Dressing/Relish/Pickled Foods/Salsa
- BG Baked Goods (Breads, Muffins, Cakes, Pies)
- S Sauces
- D Wines/Beer/Cider

Best Presentation(one overall awarded)

All judgments and placements are final. Participants must wait in a separate area during the judging. All winners will be announced on the stage and presented with a ribbon for each category. Food item will be tagged and viewed by all festival attendees under the Homemade Goods Food tent. The opinions of the judges in no way reflect the opinion of *The Heart of the Hudson Valley Bounty Festival* Organizers, their volunteers or paid employees.
